On 19 February 2007, the Commission received a notification of a proposed concentration pursuant to Article 4 of Council Regulation (EC) No 139/2004 by which the undertaking KarstadtQuelle AG ("KarstadtQuelle", Germany) acquires within the meaning of Article 3 (1)(b) of the Council Regulation sole control of the whole of the undertaking Thomas Cook AG ("Thomas Cook", Germany) by way of purchase of shares.

- 2. The business activities of the undertakings concerned are:
 - for KarstadtQuelle: European department store and mail order group;
 - for Thomas Cook: international tourism company active in the leisure travel sector.
- 3. After examination of the notification, the Commission has concluded that the notified operation falls within the scope of Council Regulation (EC) No. 139/2004 and of paragraph

- 5, subparagraph d, of the Commission Notice on a simplified procedure for treatment of certain concentrations under Council Regulation (EC) No. 139/2004².
- 4. This decision is adopted in application of Article 6 (1)(b) of Council Regulation (EC) No. 139/2004.
