- On 28 February 2007, the Commission received a notification of a proposed concentration pursuant to Article 4 of Council Regulation (EC) No 139/2004 by which the undertakings TPG Advisors V Inc. ("TPG V", USA) and Apollo Management L.P. ("Apollo", USA) acquire within the meaning of Article 3(1)(b) of the Council Regulation joint control of the undertaking Harrah's Entertainment Inc. ("Harrah's", USA) by way of purchase of shares in a company constituting a joint venture.
- 2. The business activities of the undertakings concerned are:
 - for undertaking TPG V: private equity fund;
 - for undertaking Apollo: private equity fund;
 - for undertaking Harrah's: owner and operator of casino entertainment facilities.

- 3. After examination of the notification, the Commission has concluded that the notified operation falls within the scope of Council Regulation (EC) No. 139/2004 and of paragraph 5, subparagraph b of the Commission Notice on a simplified procedure for treatment of certain concentrations under Council Regulation (EC) No. 139/2004².
- 4. For the reasons set out in the Notice on a simplified procedure, the Commission has decided not to oppose the notified operation and to declare it compatible with the common market and with the EEA Agreement. This decision is adopted in application of Article 6(1)(b) of Council Regulation (EC) No. 139/2004.
