On 04/06/2007, the Commission received a notification of a proposed concentration pursuant to Article 4 of Council Regulation (EC) No 139/2004 by which the undertaking FS Participation SAS (France) controlled by Fujitsu Limited ("Fujitsu", Japan), acquires within the meaning of Article 3(1)(b) of the Council Regulation control of the whole of the undertaking GIF Informatique ("GFI", France) by way of public bid initiated on 25 May 2007.

- 2. The business activities of the undertakings concerned are :
- for Fujitsu: manufacturing and sale of computing products, electronic devices, telecommunication products and provision of IT services
 - for GFI: provision of IT services, mainly in France
- 3. After examination of the notification, the Commission has concluded that the notified operation falls within the scope of Council Regulation (EC) No. 139/2004 and of paragraph 5, subparagraph c of the Commission Notice on a simplified procedure for treatment of certain concentrations under Council Regulation (EC) No. 139/2004².
- 4. For the reasons set out in the Notice on a simplified procedure, the Commission has decided not to oppose the notified operation and to declare it compatible with the common market and with the EEA Agreement. This decision is adopted in application of Article 6(1)(b) of Council Regulation (EC) No. 139/2004.
