- 1. On 29 August 2007, the Commission received a notification of a proposed concentration pursuant to Article 4 of Council Regulation (EC) No 139/2004 by which the undertakings Tishman Speyer Properties L.P. ("Tishman Speyer", USA) and Lehman Brothers Holdings Inc. ("Lehman Brothers", USA) acquire within the meaning of Article 3(1)(b) of the Council Regulation joint control of the undertakings Archstone-Smith Trust and Archstone-Smith Operating Trust (together "Archstone-Smith", USA).
- 2. The business activities of the undertakings concerned are:
 - for undertaking Tishman Speyer : owner, developer, fund manager and operator of commercial and residential real estate;
 - for undertaking Lehman Brothers : investment bank;
 - for undertaking Archstone-Smith : owner, developer and operator of mainly residential real estate.

- After examination of the notification, the Commission has concluded that the notified 3. operation falls within the scope of Council Regulation (EC) No. 139/2004 and of paragraph 5, subparagraph c, of the Commission Notice on a simplified procedure for treatment of certain concentrations under Council Regulation (EC) No. 139/2004².
- For the reasons set out in the Notice on a simplified procedure, the Commission has decided not to oppose the notified operation and to declare it compatible with the common market and with the EEA Agreement. This decision is adopted in application of Article 6(1)(b) of Council Regulation (EC) No. 139/2004.
