("TPG", U.S.A.) and Silver Lake Partners ("SLP", U.S.A.) acquire within the meaning of Article 3(1)(b) of the Council Regulation joint control of the undertaking Avaya Inc. ("Avaya", U.S.A.) by way of purchase of shares.
- 2. The business activities of the undertakings concerned are :
 - for TPG : private equity investment fund
 - for SLP : private equity investment fund
 - for Avaya: communications systems and applications for enterprises.
