1. On 29.04.2008, the Commission received notification of a proposed concentration pursuant to Article 4 of Council Regulation (EC) No. 139/2004 by which ArcelorMittal S.A. ("AM", Luxembourg) and Borusan Holdings A.S. ("Borusan", Turkey) acquire within the meaning of Article 3(1)(b) of the Council Regulation joint control of a Joint Venture ("JV", Turkey) by way of purchase of shares in a newly created company constituting a joint venture.

The business activities of the undertakings concerned are:

- AM: production of steel on a global basis,
- Borusan: steel, distribution, logistics, telecommunications,
- JV: hot strip steel production.
