("Corporate Express", The Netherlands) by way of a public bid announced on 19 February 2008.
- 2. The business activities of the undertakings concerned are:
- for Staples: Distribution of office supplies to small and medium-sized businesses and individuals.
- for Corporate Express: Distribution of office supplies to large businesses, distribution of printing equipment and related activities.
