On 17/06/2008, the Commission received notification of a proposed concentration pursuant to Article 4 of Council Regulation (EC) No. 139/2004 by which the undertaking PAG Acquisitions Limited ("PAG", UK), ultimately controlled by Cinven Limited ("Cinven", UK), acquires within the meaning of Article 3(1)(b) of the Council Regulation control of the whole of Partnership Group Holdings Limited ("PGHL", UK) by way of purchase of shares.
- 2. The business activities of the undertakings concerned are:
 - PAG: a newly incorporated company set up for the purpose of this transaction;
 - Cinven: private equity investor;
 - PGHL: provision of long term life insurance products.
