("Sodexo", France) acquires within the meaning of Article 3(1)(b) of the Council Regulation control of the whole of the undertaking Zehnacker Group GmbH ("Zehnacker", Germany) by way of purchase of shares.

- The business activities of the undertakings concerned are:
  - for Sodexo: Food and Facilities Management Services, service vouchers and cards,
  - for Zehnacker: full range of facilities management services, food services solutions.
- After examination of the notification, the Commission has concluded that the notified operation falls within the scope of Council Regulation (EC) No 139/2004 and of paragraph
