Notification of 26/01/2009 pursuant to Article 4 of Council Regulation (EC) No 139/2004¹

- (1) On 26/01/2009, the Commission received a notification of a proposed concentration pursuant to Art. 4 of of Council Regulation (EC) No 139/2004 by which One Equity Partners (OEP), a private equity investment company, ultimately controlled by JPMorgan Chase & Co (JPMC) will acquire sole control within the meaning of Article 3(1)(b) of the Merger Regulation over Columbian Chemicals Holding LLC (CCH), a company currently controlled by DC Chemical Co., Ltd. through purchase of shares.

The business activities of the undertakings concerned are:

- for JPMC: financial service activities, except insurance and pension funding
- for CCH: manufacture of chemicals and chemical products.

- (2) After examination of the notification, the Commission has concluded that the notified operation falls within the scope of Council Regulation (EC) No 139/2004 and of paragraph 5(b) of the Commission Notice on a simplified procedure for treatment of certain concentrations under Council Regulation (EC) No 139/2004².
- (3) For the reasons set out in the Notice on a simplified procedure, the Commission has decided not to oppose the notified operation and to declare it compatible with the common market and with the EEA Agreement. This decision is adopted in application of Article 6(1)(b) of Council Regulation (EC) No 139/2004.
