On 14.09.2009, the Commission received notification of a proposed concentration pursuant to Article 4 of Council Regulation (EC) No 139/2004 by which the undertaking McJunkin Red Man Corporation ("McJunkin", United States of America) controlled by the Goldman Sachs Group, Inc. (United States of America) acquires within the meaning of Article 3(1)(b) of the Council Regulation control of the whole of the undertaking Transmark Fcx Group BV ("Transmark", The Netherlands) by way of purchase of shares.

The business activities of the undertakings concerned are:

 for McJunkin: distribution of pipes, valves, fittings, and related products and services to industrial customers primarily in North America,

- for Transmark: distribution of valves and other related products and services to industrial customers mainly in Europe, but also in South-East Asia, Australia, New Zealand and Africa.
- 2. After examination of the notification, the Commission has concluded that the notified operation falls within the scope of Council Regulation (EC) No 139/2004 and of paragraph 5(c) of the Commission Notice on a simplified procedure for treatment of certain concentrations under Council Regulation (EC) No 139/2004².
- 3. For the reasons set out in the Notice on a simplified procedure, the Commission has decided not to oppose the notified operation and to declare it compatible with the common market and with the EEA Agreement. This decision is adopted in application of Article 6(1)(b) of Council Regulation (EC) No 139/2004.
