**Subject: Case M.8232 – Diamond Offshore Wind Holdings II / Eneco Wind Belgium / Elnu / Norther  
Commission decision pursuant to Article 6(1)(b) of Council Regulation (EC) No 139/2004<sup>1</sup> and Article 57 of the Agreement on the European Economic Area<sup>2</sup>**

Dear Sir or Madam,

1. On 14/10/2016, the European Commission received notification of a proposed concentration pursuant to Article 4 of the Merger Regulation by which Eneco Wind Belgium NV ('EWB', Belgium) controlled by Eneco Holding NV, Elnu NV (Belgium) controlled by Elicio NV, and Diamond Offshore Wind Holdings II BV ('DOWH', The Netherlands) controlled by Mitsubishi Corporation, acquire within the meaning of Article 3(1)(b) of the Merger Regulation joint control of Norther NV ('Norther', Belgium) by way of purchase of shares.<sup>3</sup>
2. The business activities of the undertakings concerned are:
  - EWB is active in Belgium in the production of electricity from wind energy. EWB participates in and manages both 'onshore' and 'offshore' wind farm projects. For onshore wind farms, EWB is active at both the development stage and the exploitation stage, for offshore wind farms, EWB is in Belgium currently only active at the development stage.

- Elnu is a 100 % subsidiary of Elicio NV ('Elicio'). In Belgium, Elicio (through its subsidiaries) generates electricity from operational onshore wind farms and is developing various projects relating to the production of biomass and wind energy (including offshore wind farms). Elicio is a subsidiary of Nethys SA.
  - DOWH is a vehicle set up by Diamond Generating Europe Limited, a 100% subsidiary of Mitsubishi Corporation ('MC'). MC is a Japanese company active at global level in various industries. It currently does not have any activities in Belgium in the wind sector.
  - Norther is an existing joint venture between EWB and Elnu. Norther will own, operate and maintain a wind farm located in the North Sea.
3. After examination of the notification, the European Commission has concluded that the notified operation falls within the scope of the Merger Regulation and of paragraph 5 (a) of the Commission Notice on a simplified procedure for treatment of certain concentrations under Council Regulation (EC) No 139/2004.<sup>4</sup>
4. For the reasons set out in the Notice on a simplified procedure, the European Commission has decided not to oppose the notified operation and to declare it compatible with the internal market and with the EEA Agreement. This decision is adopted in application of Article 6(1)(b) of the Merger Regulation and Article 57 of the EEA Agreement.
