Description of the concentration

On 18 November 2020, the European Commission received a notification of a proposed concentration pursuant to Article 4 of Council Regulation (EC) No 139/2004 (Merger "Regulation") by which Deutsche Telekom AG ("Deutsche Telekom"), Bonn, Germany, and SK Telecom Co., Ltd, Seoul, Korea ("SKT") intend to set-up a full-function, jointly controlled Joint Venture ("JV"), with its seat in Germany.

The JV will be dedicated to the development of radio frequency repeater technology and the licensing of resulting intellectual property rights to third parties.
