## **SECTION 1.2**

## **Description of the concentration**

On 6 April 2021, the Commission received a notification of a proposed concentration pursuant to Article 4 of Council Regulation (EC) No 139/2004, by which AES, Coatue and Schneider Electric intend to acquire indirect joint control over Uplight.

The business activities of the undertakings concerned are:

- (a) AES (incorporated in Delaware, United States): AES is a Fortune 500 global energy company which mainly operates thermal and renewable electricity generation and distribution businesses.
- (b) Coatue (formed in Delaware, United States): Coatue is a global investment manager focused on technology, media and communications industries. Coatue currently has approximately \$40 billion in assets under management.
- (c) Schneider Electric (incorporated in France): Schneider Electric is the ultimate parent company of an international group that is mainly active in power management medium voltage, low voltage and secure power and in various types of software solutions and products for automation and energy management.
- (d) Uplight: Uplight is a U.S.-based energy solutions company providing utilities with the software that enables end-consumers to monitor and adjust their energy consumption habits to reduce usage and costs.
