SECTION 1.2

Description of the concentration

The Commission has received notification of a proposed concentration pursuant to Article 4 of the EUMR, by which: (i) Abu Dhabi Future Energy Company PJSC (Masdar), Abu Dhabi, United Arab Emirates, through its indirect subsidiary Masdar CES Europe B.V.; (ii) Taaleri Energia Ltd. (Taaleri Energia), Finland, through its subsidiary Taaleri Energia Holdings Sarl; (iii) KYOTO S.A. (KYOTO), Greece; and (iv) AUTOHELLAS TOURIST AND TRADING SOCIETE ANONYME (Autohellas), Greece, intend to establish a joint venture (JV), within the meaning of Article 3(4) of the EUMR, with the view of developing the Asopia solar PV power plant project with a capacity of up to 65 MW (Asopia Solar Power Plant), located in Central Greece.

Masdar is an Abu Dhabi-based renewable energy and sustainability company that advances solutions in energy, water, urban development and clean technologies in the UAE and around the world.

Taaleri Energia is a Finnish-based wind and solar developer and fund manager investing in utility scale wind farms and solar plants. Taaleri Energia is part of the Taaleri Group.

KYOTO is a Greek *société anonyme* active in the development of real estate and energy projects.

Autohellas is a Greek *société anonyme* active, amongst others, in the market of car rental, import and trade.
