## **SECTION 1.2**

## **Description of the concentration**

- On 12 October 2021, the Commission received notification of a proposed concentration pursuant to Article 4 of Council Regulation (EC) No. 139/2004 by which The Goldman Sachs Group, Inc. ("Goldman Sachs") and ENEOS Holdings, Inc. ("Eneos") intend to acquire indirect joint control of NIPPO CORPORATION ("Nippo") and its subsidiaries within the meaning of Article 3(1)(b) of Council Regulation (EC) No 139/2004.
- 2. Before the transaction, Nippo is a publicly listed company solely controlled by Eneos. Following implementation of the transaction, Goldman Sachs and Eneos will indirectly acquire joint control of Nippo.
- 3. Goldman Sachs is a global investment banking, securities and investment management firm that provides a range of banking, securities and investment services worldwide to a substantial and diversified client base that includes corporations, financial institutions, governments and high-net-worth individuals.
- 4. Eneos is a Japan-based company mainly engaged in the energy business, oil and gas development business, and metal business.
- **5.** Nippo is a Japan-based company mainly engaged in the construction business, as well as the manufacture and sale of asphalt mixtures. Nippo is currently controlled by Eneos.
