BGTF Renewable Holdings Limited is controlled by Brookfield Asset Management Inc. ("Brookfield"), a global alternative asset manager with over USD 625 billion of assets under management. The company has a 120-year history of owning and operating assets with a focus on real estate, renewable power, infrastructure, private equity and credit. Brookfield offers a range of public and private investment products and services and is co-listed on the New York Stock Exchange and Toronto Stock Exchange.

The Target is currently controlled by Acek and the executive founders of Powen through a common vehicle (Holdco Kishoa, S.L.).
