Description of the concentration

The Carlyle Group, Inc. ("Carlyle") intends to acquire joint control over Duravant LLC ("Duravant"), together with Warburg Pincus LLC ("Warburg Pincus"). Warburg Pincus currently has sole control over Duravant.
