SECTION 1.2

Description of the concentration

The European Commission has received notification of a proposed concentration under Article 4 of Council Regulation (EC) No. 139/2004 ("EUMR"), pursuant to which Telia Towers AB (the "Buyer"), an entity jointly controlled by (i) Telia Company AB ("Telia Company") and (ii) Infracore Nordic Bidco AB ("Infracore"), a limited company incorporated in Sweden and indirectly controlled by Brookfield Asset Management Inc. ("Brookfield"), will acquire 100% of the issued share capital in Telia Towers Sweden AB (the "Target") from Telia Company. As a result of the Proposed Transaction, Infracore and Telia Company will hold joint control over the Target within the meaning of Article 3(1)(b) of EUMR.

The Buyer is a holding company incorporated in Sweden. Its wholly owned subsidiaries, Telia Towers Norway AS and Telia Towers Finland OY, own, manage and provide access to passive wireless communications infrastructure to wireless communications providers respectively in Norway and Finland.

Brookfield, headquartered in Canada, provides asset management services, focused on real estate, infrastructure, renewable power and private equity. Brookfield is headquartered in Toronto, Canada.

Telia Company, headquartered in Sweden, is a telecommunications operator providing mobile and fixed telecommunications services, as well as broadband and television services.

The Target owns, manages and provides access to passive wireless communications infrastructure to wireless communications providers in Sweden.
