## Subject:Case M.10934 – VINCI ENERGIES / KONTRON IT SERVICE<br/>COMPANIES<br/>Commission decision pursuant to Article 6(1)(b) of Council Regulation<br/>(EC) No 139/2004<sup>1</sup> and Article 57 of the Agreement on the European<br/>Economic Area<sup>2</sup>

Dear Sir or Madam,

- On 21 October 2022, the European Commission received notification of a proposed concentration pursuant to Article 4 of the Merger Regulation, by which VINCI Energies S.A. ('VINCI Energies', France), a subsidiary of VINCI S.A. (France), the ultimate parent company of the VINCI Group, will acquire within the meaning of Article 3(1)(b) eight of Kontron AG's IT service companies, including their direct and indirect subsidiaries ('Kontron IT Service Companies'): Amanox Solutions AG (Switzerland), S&T Albania SH.p.k. (Albania), S&T Serbia d.o.o. (Serbia), hamcos IT Service GmbH (Germany), S&T Deutschland GmbH (Germany), S&T Mold srl., (Moldova), CITYCOMP Service GmbH, (Germany) and S&T CEE Holding s.r.o., (Slovakia), by way of purchase of shares.<sup>3</sup>
- 2. The business activities of the undertakings concerned are the following:
  - VINCI is a global diversified organization active in concessions and infrastructure, building, public works, civil engineering and energy. Within VINCI Group, VINCI Energies, which belongs to the Vinci Group division "Energies", is also active, through its brand line Axians, in the area of IT services. The Axiansnetwork of companies provides IT services, such as cloud & data center

infrastructures, enterprise networks, digital workspace, business applications & data analytics and cybersecurity.

- Kontron IT Service Companies are primarily active in offering consultancy services on IT infrastructure such as data centers and cloud services and the conception of tailored IT network and security concepts for on-site and cloud infrastructure. Furthermore, the Kontron IT Service Companies offer also the implementation, integration and supply of IT infrastructure and software applications and solutions (such as Enterprise Resource Planning, application software (Customer Relationship Management) or Business Intelligence software).
- 3. After examination of the notification, the European Commission has concluded that the notified operation falls within the scope of the Merger Regulation and of paragraph 5(c) of the Commission Notice on a simplified procedure for treatment of certain concentrations under Council Regulation (EC) No 139/2004.<sup>4</sup>
- 4. For the reasons set out in the Notice on a simplified procedure, the European Commission has decided not to oppose the notified operation and to declare it compatible with the internal market and with the EEA Agreement. This decision is adopted in application of Article 6(1)(b) of the Merger Regulation and Article 57 of the EEA Agreement.
