SECTION 1.2

Description of the concentration

On 13 December 2022, the Commission received a notification of a proposed concentration pursuant to Article 4 of Council Regulation (EC) No 139/2004 (the “EUMR”). The proposed transaction involves the acquisition of sole control (within the meaning of Article 3(1)(b) EUMR) by Infinite Electronics International, Inc. (“Infinite Electronics”) of Cable Connectivity Group B.V. (“CCG”).

Infinite Electronics is a supplier of electronic components, serving engineers’ needs in a diverse set of end-markets, including aerospace, defence, broadband, and wireless infrastructure, through a family of highly recognized brands paired with expert technical support. It is headquartered in Irvine, California, United States and is predominantly active in the United States. It is controlled by Warburg Pincus LLC, a global private equity firm headquartered in New York, United States.

CCG, headquartered in Benthuizen, the Netherlands, is active in the production, distribution, and assembly of specialty cables and cable connectivity solutions. CCG has customers in end-markets such as machine building, agriculture, crane- and lift industry, healthcare and medical, railway, marine, offshore, installation food & beverage, aeronautics, and aerospace.
