## **Description of the concentration**

- (1) This notification concerns the following undertakings:
  - (a) KKR & Co. Inc. ("KKR & Co." and together with its subsidiaries, "KKR"), Delaware, United States; and
  - (b) Infracapital Greenfield Partners II (Euro) SCSp and Infracapital Greenfield Partners II (Sterling) SCSp, investment funds acting by their manager M&G Alternatives Investment Management Limited ("MGAIM") and forming part of M&G plc's ("M&G") infrastructure investment business, Infracapital ("Infracapital"), United Kingdom. MGAIM is a wholly-owned subsidiary of M&G.
- (2) On 15 September 2023, KKR and Infracapital notified their intention to acquire indirect joint control of Zenobe Energy Limited ("**Target**") within the meaning of Articles 3(1)(b) and 3(4) of Council Regulation (EC) No 139/2004.
- (3) The concentration will be accomplished by way of acquisition of shares.
- (4) The business activities of the undertakings concerned are as follows: (a) KKR is a global investment firm that offers alternative asset management as well as capital markets and insurance solutions.
  - (b) Infracapital is a European infrastructure investment firm.
  - (c) Target is a company headquartered in the United Kingdom. It provides end-to-end solutions for fleet electrification, including charging infrastructure, battery replacement and software solutions. In addition, Target designs, finances, builds and operates battery energy storage systems and repurposes batteries.
