Description of the concentration

The notified concentration concerns the proposed acquisition of indirect sole control within the meaning of Article (3)(1)(b) of the Council Regulation (EC) No 139/2004 of 20 January 2004 (the "EU Merger Regulation") of Schoeller Packaging Holding B.V., the indirect holding company of Schoeller Allibert Group B.V. (and together with its direct and indirect subsidiaries, "Schoeller Allibert"), by BCP IV RTP Holdings Limited, an entity which is ultimately controlled by Brookfield Corporation (collectively, "Brookfield" and together with Schoeller Allibert, the "Parties") (the "Proposed Transaction").

Schoeller Allibert is currently indirectly jointly controlled by Brookfield and Schoeller Industries B.V. Following the completion of the Proposed Transaction, Brookfield will indirectly exercise sole control over Schoeller Allibert.
