**SECTION 1.2**

**Description of the concentration**

On 5 January 2024, CMA CGM S.A. (“CMA CGM”), a French company whose headquarters are in Marseille, notified to the Commission a proposed concentration pursuant to Article 4 of Council Regulation (EC) No 139/2004, whereby it intends to acquire, within the meaning of Article 3(1)(b) of the Council Regulation, sole control over Bolloré Logistics SE (“Bolloré Logistics”), a French-based company, *via* a share purchase deal.

CMA CGM is active at world level in container liner shipping and port terminal services. Through its subsidiary CEVA Logistics S.A. (“CEVA Logistics”), CMA CGM is also active in freight forwarding and contract logistics services. In the EEA, CEVA Logistics is active in Austria, Belgium, Croatia, the Czech Republic, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Ireland, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, the Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia, Spain, and Sweden.

Bolloré Logistics is active in freight forwarding and contract logistics services. Bolloré Logistics operates in particular in Europe (in France as well as in Austria, Belgium, the Czech Republic, Denmark, Finland, Germany, Hungary, Ireland, Italy, Luxembourg, the Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Spain and Sweden).
