<b>Description</b>	Plush toy in the form of a dragon made of green textile material with a soft filling and a pair of stumpy orange wings with colourless, transparent crackling foil inside; with sewn-on labels and attached cardboard label with marking.

<b>Risk type</b>	Chemical
<b>Risk</b>	The crackling foils inside the wings contain di-(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP) (measured value 4.1% by weight). This phthalate may harm the health of children, causing possible damage to the reproductive system. According to the REACH Regulation, DEHP, DBP and BBP phthalates are prohibited in all toys and childcare articles.
