

The *Weekly overview reports of RAPEX notifications* (hereinafter called 'the RAPEX notifications') published by the Directorate-General Justice and Consumers on the European Union's official website 'Europa', may be reused for commercial and non-commercial purposes, free of charge and on a non-exclusive basis, in paper form or in any electronic format, throughout the world, for the full legal term of copyright and on terms that the copyright in the original RAPEX notifications vests exclusively in the European Union, provided the following conditions are met:

a) The original meaning or message of the RAPEX notifications is not distorted, i.e.:

- no changes of substance to the existing texts or illustrations are made;
- photos incorporated in the RAPEX notifications are not used in any context other than the re-dissemination thereof within the original context of the RAPEX notifications;
- in case of a translation, the latter is not published under any principal title other than a direct translation into the target language of the following title *Weekly overview reports of RAPEX notifications*;
- the relevant Week and Year of the RAPEX notifications report are clearly mentioned on the final product;
- the final product is forthwith modified according to the updates published by the Directorate-General Justice and Consumers.

In that context, on first publication of the reused RAPEX notifications, you are kindly invited to inform the Directorate-General Justice and Consumers (e-mail: JUST-OP-LICENCES@ec.europa.eu) of the web address/es on which it is (they are) displayed, and/or deliver an electronic version thereof (e.g. PDF) if published in paper form.
