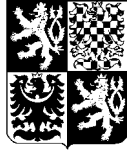

399<sup>th</sup> RESOLUTION  
OF THE SENATE

delivered on the 15<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 17<sup>th</sup> March 2010

**on Proposal for a Directive of the European Parliament and of the Council on minimum standards for the qualification and status of third country nationals or stateless persons as beneficiaries of international protection and the content of the protection granted**  
(Senate Press no. N 081/07)

**The Senate**

- I. **Is aware of the fact**  
that the current qualification directive embodies certain insufficiencies that create problems in decision-making on entitlement to international protection;
- II. **1. Is of the opinion,**  
in accordance with its previous resolutions, that recasts should be based on thorough evaluation of already existing tools. Only by long-term gathering of extensive amount of data it is possible to fully identify problematic aspects and cover them by a complex regulation;  
**2. Believes**  
that there should be a clear distinction between asylum and subsidiary protection, as those are two instruments with different logic. Each of them should thus be bound to different set of rights for persons that are granted international protection;
- III. **1. Requests**  
the Government to inform the Senate about the way this position was taken into account and to provide the Senate with further information on the proceeding of negotiations;  
**2. Authorises**  
the President of the Senate to forward this resolution to the European Commission.
