on the Communication from the Commission to the European Parliament, the Council and the European Economic and Social Committee – A European strategy on clean and energy efficient vehicles

# The Senate

I.

## Regards

the strategy as proposed by the Commission to be well-balanced and, at the same time, considers its extent of ambition to be adequate to the current economic situation in the EU;

#### II.

1. Supports

the technologically neutral tone of the strategy;

2. Underlines the importance

of the standardization and common norms for new technologies and infrastructure networks based on these technologies;

3. Regards as crucial

that, when preparing new European standards for clean and energy efficient cars, the conditions of non-European car makers are taken into account so that the competitiveness of the European car industry is not jeopardized;

#### 4. Invites

the Commission to focus on the non-discriminative impact on individual producers when drafting proposals for demand-side support measures for green cars;

# 5. Appeals

to the Commission to update the strategy relating to bio-fuels so that it reflects the current state of scientific research in this area;

# 1. Requests

the government to inform the Senate about the way this position was taken into account, and about following initiatives by the Commission;

## 2. Authorises

the President of the Senate to forward this resolution to the European Commission.
