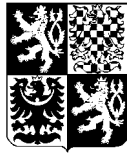

577th RESOLUTION

OF THE SENATE

delivered on the 24th meeting held on 27th October 2010

on Proposal for a Directive of the European Parliament and of the Council on conditions of entry and residence of third-country nationals in the framework of an intra-corporate transfer

(Senate Press no. N 127/07)

The Senate of the Parliament of the Czech Republic

I. Is aware of

the repeated requests of transnational companies for establishment of a comprehensible European framework for intra-corporate transfers and is of the opinion that the proposal for a Directive could generally contribute to the satisfaction of these requests;

II. 1. Assumes

that the regulation of access of intra-corporate transferees to the systems of social welfare, as defined in Article 14 of the proposal, could lead to duplication of insurance payments by the intra-corporate transferees, whereas it points out that, according to the experience of the Czech Republic, large number of these persons want to maintain their home country insurance;

2. Is of the opinion

that the mobility of intra-corporate transferees, as set in Article 16, is defined too vaguely, in particular there are no sufficient guarantees of adherence to the principle that each Member State can regulate the number of intra-corporate transferees in its territory, moreover, the procedural aspects related to this mobility are not defined clearly, too;

3. Requests

clarification of the term “specialist” as regards level of qualification gained;

4. Requests

elaboration of security criteria for assessing of credibility of companies pursuant to Article 10 Paragraph 7 of the proposal;

III.

1. Requests

the Government to inform the Senate about the way this position was taken into account and to provide the Senate with further information on the proceeding of negotiations;

2. Authorises

the President of the Senate to forward this resolution to the European Commission.
