## Resolution of the Senate

delivered on the 12<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 7<sup>th</sup> October 2011

**on the proposal for a Directive of the European Parliament and of the Council  
establishing minimum standards on the rights, support and protection of  
victims of crime**

**(Senate Press no. N 059/08)**

### The Senate

**1. Is aware**

of the need for the cross-border protection of victims and considers a complex regulation, that the directive represents to be the right step forward;

**2. Is of the opinion**

that the requirement for free of charge translations set in the Article 6 of the proposal is defined too broadly, which could lead to supplemental financial costs for the individual Member States;

**3. Authorises**

the President of the Senate to forward this Resolution to the European Commission.
