Resolution of the Senate

delivered on the 12th meeting held on 7th October 2011

on the proposal for a Directive of the European Parliament and of the Council establishing minimum standards on the rights, support and protection of victims of crime

(Senate Press no. N 059/08)

The Senate

1. Is aware

of the need for the cross-border protection of victims and considers a complex regulation, that the directive represents to be the right step forward;

2. Is of the opinion

that the requirement for free of charge translations set in the Article 6 of the proposal is defined too broadly, which could lead to supplemental financial costs for the individual Member States;

3. Authorises

the President of the Senate to forward this Resolution to the European Commission.
