RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE

552nd RESOLUTION

delivered on the 19th meeting held on 14th March 2012

**on Proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council establishing
"ERASMUS FOR ALL": the Union Programme for Education, Training, Youth and Sport**

(Senate Press no. N 115/08)

I.

1. Expresses

in accordance with long-term position of the Senate, as stated in the 372nd resolution of 10 December 2009 on the Green Paper "Promoting the learning mobility of young people", its support for the proposal for a regulation, especially with regard to the proven usefulness of mobility for new skill acquisition, language skill improvement, personal development of young people, and the positive impact of mobility on the improvement of the quality of educational institutions;

2. Recalls

that in accordance with the 336th resolution of the Senate of 10 October 2011 on the Green Paper "Modernising the Professional Qualifications Directive", enhanced mobility of qualified professionals in the EU should not be detrimental to public health or consumer rights, while the strictest rules should be preserved in particular among health professionals;

II.

1. Supports

the increase of resources for education as a proof of the mobilisation of European money for a better employability of young people in the labour market;

2. Suggests

differentiation among the formal education programme components, as their names are well-established and understandable among the public and employers;

3. Points out

the significant differences between formal and non-formal education, and therefore recommends to keep a separate programme for non-formal education;

4. Recommends

to clarify the role of Erasmus for all programme and European Social Fund in the frame of cooperation between educational institutions and business to avoid project duplication;
