RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE

Delivered on the 19th session held on 15 March 2012

on the Proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council on the establishment of a Programme for the Environment and Climate Action (LIFE)

(Senate Press no. N 139/08)

The Senate of the Parliament of the Czech Republic

I.

Welcomes the increase of resources for the LIFE programme and stresses the need for their most efficient use in the selection and implementation of concrete projects;

II.

- Considers it to be desirable that the initiatives of the Commission in one area, in this case the environment and climate, demonstrated greater mutual interconnection and also indicated a stronger coherence between individual documents;
- 2. Regrets the fact that programme LIFE is not linked sufficiently with European Earth monitoring programme (GMES), since they are to a large extent related;
- **3. Recommends** to draw conclusions from the fact that existing procedures striving to mitigate global warming were essentially ineffective, and it is therefore necessary to concentrate on the causes of this situation;
- **4. Is of the opinion** that the EU should incorporate the latest scientific findings into its consideration of further steps in combating climate change;
