Dear Mr. President,

I would like to inform you about the opinion of the Committee for European Affairs of the Chamber of Deputies of the Parliament of the Czech Republic on the Communication from the Commission to the European Parliament, the Council, the European Economic and Social Committee and the Committee of the Regions - Making the internal energy market work /Council No. 16202/12, COM(2012) 663 final/.

The respective document was included in the agenda of the 43rd session of the Committee for European Affairs and was scrutinized on 28th February 2013. According to the Rules of Procedure of the Chamber of Deputies a Deputy Minister of Industry and Trade was present at the session to introduce the preliminary government's framework position.

After the hearing of the rapporteur's review and after the discussion the Committee has adopted the resolution No. 301 which is enclosed to this letter. According to this resolution the Committee i. a. would welcome the inclusion of the issue of unscheduled power flows among the priority measures, since it is a problem that directly affects the electricity infrastructure of the Czech Republic and other neighboring states in the region. And also points out market distortions caused by non-market support for renewable energy.
