The Proposal for a Council decision establishing provisional measurers in the area of international protection for the benefit of Italy, Greece and Hungary /COM (2015) 451 final/.

## Conclusions of the Resolution:

Committee for European Affairs

- 1. disagrees with the Proposal for a Council decision establishing provisional measurers in the area of international protection for the benefit of Italy, Greece and Hungary (COM (2015) 451 final), and in particular disagrees with its adoption by the Council Decision (EU) 2015/1601 establishing provisional measures in the area of international protection for the benefit of Italy and Greece;
- 2. continuously **strongly rejects** allocation of any quotas for compulsory redistribution of refugees within the EU, whether in this form, or even in the form of the proposed permanent relocation mechanism;
- 3. considers these measures to be ineffective and repeatedly stresses that these measures do not present the solution to the current migration crisis;
- 4. **highlights** a number of unsolved questions regarding the practical implementation of relocations, especially when it comes to secondary movements of relocated people, but also the factual process of their relocation to the countries of destination;
- 5. calls on the Czech Government to insist on its preferences regarding the persons who will be relocated to the Czech Republic during the implementation of both approved temporary relocation mechanisms, and to make sure with the greatest care that there will be no individuals amongst incoming people, that could impersonate security risk or other risks for the citizens of the Czech Republic;
- 6. calls on the Czech Government to inform the Committee for European Affairs and the Subcommittee on Migration and Asylum Policy on the progress of implementation of relocations:
- 7. **authorizes** the Chairman of the Committee for European Affairs to inform the President of the European Commission on the content of this resolution.
