**RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE**

Delivered on the 9<sup>th</sup> session held on 16<sup>th</sup> August 2017

**on the Proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council on establishing a single digital gateway to provide information, procedures, assistance and problem solving services and amending Regulation (EU) No 1024/2012 (Senate Print No. N 42/11; COM (2017) 256)**

**The Senate**

**I.**

**1. Fully supports**

this proposal in the option of as deep integration in the area as possible; the proposed measures will have a clear positive effect on the smooth functioning of the EU single market and removing barriers and they will substantially increase the comfort of both citizens and companies, which must certainly be assessed as positive;

**2. Is of an opinion,**

that given these benefits it is possible to also accept the proposed feedback in the form of collection of data and information by the EU institutions;

**II.**

**1. Proposes**

in Annex 1 to this proposal for a Regulation, noting that the ownership and management of real estate is not harmonized at the EU level, to add to the list of areas of information relevant to citizens the area of real estate, which would include in particular:

- purchase and sale of real estate;
- taxation of real estate in another Member State;
- public property registers and entries therein;
- rights and obligations associated with the ownership and use of real estate;

## **2. Further proposes**

to deepen, as much as possible, the range of procedures and services in the single digital gateway, with an emphasis on the possibility of on-line tax returns and payment of taxes, as well as filing administrative and judicial petitions;

## **III.**

### **1. Requests**

the Government to inform the Senate about the way this resolution was taken into account and about further development of negotiations once the political agreement of the required number of Member States on the main elements of the proposal is reached, or at an earlier time, should the results of negotiations in the Council begin to depart considerably from the position of the Czech Republic expressed in the General Position of the Government;

### **2. Authorises**

the President of the Senate to forward this Resolution to the European Commission.
