69th Session on September 21, 2017

Reflection Paper on the Deepening of the Economic and Monetary Union, COM (2017) 291 final, Council Code 9940/17

Conclusions of the Resolution:

Committee for European Affairs

1. **takes note of** the Annex of the Reflection Paper on the Deepening of the Economic and Monetary Union, COM (2017) 291 final, Council Code 9940/17;
2. **supports** the Government's Framework Position on the Reflection Paper on the Deepening of the Economic and Monetary Union, COM (2017) 291 final, Council Code 9940/17;
3. **agrees** with the Government's Framework Position concerning the promotion of better involvement of national parliaments in creating of EU legislation;
4. **supports** the strengthening of further cooperation and the development of dialogue with the Member States on the European Semester, especially greater involvement of national parliaments;
5. **considers** that before starting new projects Member States should focus on the implementation and application of existing EU rules relating to economic and monetary union (e.g. over-indebtedness);
6. **considers** that regarding the necessary differences in the integration of Eurozone Member States and Member States outside the Eurozone, is necessary to create to maintain the integrity of the internal market and the consistency of policies across the EU;
7. **authorizes** the Chairman of the European Affairs Committee to forward this resolution to the President of the European Commission **in the context of the Political Dialogue.**
