Delivered on the 13th session held on 4th April 2018

on the Communication from the Commission to the European Parliament, the Council and the European Economic and Social Committee

Action Plan 2017-2019 Tackling the gender pay gap

(Senate Print no. K 086/11, COM(2017) 678)

The Senate

I.

1. Got acquainted

with the EU Action Plan 2017-2019 Tackling the Gender Pay Gap submitted by the Commission in November 2017;

2. Supports

non-legislative measures to support equal pay for women and men suggested by the Commission in the Action Plan;

II.

1. Is Aware

that the inequality of income of women and men in the Czech Republic counts among the highest within the EU and that this inequality has a significant impact on the quality of life of women, men and their children during their productive and post-productive years;

2. Is convinced

- that the Government should take measures to correct this inequality;
- that such measures include tools for work-life balance, i. e. support for part-time jobs and flexible working conditions or sufficient capacity of early childhood and long-term care facilities; in this regard, the Senate points out to its Resolution No. 254 from 16th August 2017 on the Proposal for a Directive of the European Parliament and of the Council on work-life balance

for parents and carers and repealing Council Directive 2010/18/EU (Senate Print No. N 036/11);

3. Urges therefore the Government

to prepare a complex long-term strategy for a gradual decrease in inequality of income of women and men in their productive and post-productive years;

III.

1. Requests

the Government to inform the Senate about the way this resolution was taken into account and about further development of negotiations;

2. Authorises

the President of the Senate to forward this Resolution to the European Commission.
