### **RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE**

Delivered on the 14<sup>th</sup> session held on 25<sup>th</sup> April 2018

on the Proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council on the mutual recognition of goods lawfully marketed in another Member State (Senate Print No. N99/11; COM(2017) 796)

#### **The Senate**

I.

#### 1. Agrees

with the declared objectives and with the proposed instruments to achieve them;

#### 2. Considers

that the proposed measures could produce the intended effect and, ultimately, help to simplify and streamline decision-making processes in the field of mutual recognition of goods lawfully marketed in another Member State;

#### 3. Therefore identifies

with the position of the Government of the Czech Republic and agrees with the proposed Regulation;

#### II.

#### 1. Requests

the Government to inform the Senate about the way this Resolution was taken into account and about further development of negotiations once the political agreement of the required number of Member States on the main elements of the proposal is reached, or at an earlier time, should the results of negotiations in the Council begin to depart considerably from the position of the Czech Republic expressed in the General Position of the Government;

#### 2. Authorises

the President of the Senate to forward this Resolution to the European Commission.
