5. **has reservations** on harmonization of administrative sanctions for large infringement cases, since in the field of administrative cooperation the EU only has competence to carry out actions to support, coordinate or supplement the actions of the Member States within the meaning of Article 6 TFEU ;
6. **welcomes** the introduction of the possibility to sanction the dual quality of food as unfair commercial practice;

9. **considers** it important that Member States keep the right to adopt or maintain their own collective redress laws, which differ in certain aspects from the rules contained in the draft directive;
