RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE

Delivered on the 17th session held on 15th August 2018

on the Proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council on the marketing and use of explosives precursors, amending Annex XVII to Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 and repealing Regulation (EU) No 98/2013 on the marketing and use of explosives precursors

The Senate

I.

1. Agrees

with the Position of the Government on the proposed tightening up of the existing rules for the access to substances that could be used for the illicit manufacture of explosives;

2. Requests,

in accord with the Government, to modify the definition of a "restricted explosives precursor" in a way so as to include also mixtures of two or more precursors, in which the limit values for individual precursors are not exceeded;

3. Does not support

the introduction of an obligation of Member States to organize awareness-raising actions at least twice a year;

4. Also requests,

in accord with the Government, to prolong the proposed transposition period of the proposal;

II.

1. Requests

the Government to inform the Senate about the way this resolution was taken into account and about further development of negotiations once the political agreement of the required number of Member States on the main elements of the proposals is reached, or at an earlier time, should the results of negotiations in the Council begin to depart considerably from the position of the Czech Republic expressed in the General Position of the Government;

2. Authorizes

the President of the Senate to forward this resolution to the European Commission.
