RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE

Delivered on the 12th session held on 9th June 2021

on the Communication from the Commission to the European Parliament, the Council, the European Economic and Social Committee and the Committee of the Regions The European Pillar of Social Rights Action Plan (Senate Print no. K 30/13, COM(2021) 102)

The Senate

I.

1. Is convinced

that the European Pillar of Social Rights Action Plan (AP EPSP) is in compliance with the long-term goals of the Czech Republic;

2. Therefore agrees

with the fundamental goals, which the European Commission proposed in the fields of employment, skills, and social protections to be accomplished by 2030;

3. Emphasises however,

that the proposed initiatives of the AP EPSP have to respect the division of competences and should be in compliance with the principle of subsidiarity;

4. Supports the position of the Government of the Czech Republic

which welcomed AP EPSP in its position, but lacked a greater focus on the elderly and their inclusion in the labour market and society in the context of demographical changes and twin transition of the economy and society, which could be suitably linked to EPSP principles;

II.

1. Requests

the Government to inform the Senate no later than on 30 November 2021 about the way this Resolution was taken into account;
