#### RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE

## The Senate

I.

## 1. Appreciates

drafting of a renewed EU action plan against smuggling, where activities for the upcoming five-year period are mentioned;

#### 2. Draws attention

to the fact that smuggling is linked with high crime profits, which are subsequently used for financing of other illegal activities;

#### 3. Therefore supports

the European Commission's opinion that every investigation into a smuggling case should be accompanied by a financial crime investigation so that the profits from smuggling can be traced and seized:

## 4. Agrees

that we should take joint action within the European Union to help prevent smuggling; in this respect, the Senate very much welcomes the renewed action plan's emphasis on awareness raising and information campaigns;

### 5. Also agrees

that effective cooperation with countries of origin and transit is essential in responding to smuggling; the Senate considers useful to link migration, asylum and security issues with trade, education and cultural cooperation in agreements and partnerships with third countries;

#### II.

## 1. Considers unacceptable

that migration is being instrumentalised on the international level as a form of pressure on the EU and/or its Member States;

## 2. Will pay attention

to this issue and will discuss relevant legislative proposals of the European Commission aimed at preventing and/or responding effectively to the instrumentalisation of migration;

## 3. Asks

the Government of the Czech Republic and the European Commission to continue adopting measures aimed at responding strongly to the state-sponsored and calculated abuse of irregular migration;

### III.

#### 1. Requests

the Government to inform the Senate no later than on 31st July 2022 on the further progress of the legislative proposals for a new migration and asylum pact as well as on further steps taken in relation to the current situation on the external border with Belarus;

#### 2. Authorises

the President of the Senate to forward this Resolution to the European Commission.
