RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE

Delivered on the 30th session held on 12th October 2022

on the Proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and the Council on the European Health Data Space /Senate Print no. N 179/13, COM(2022) 197/

I.

1. Got acquainted

with the Proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and the Council on the European Health Data Space;

2. Supports

the position of the Government of the Czech Republic on the Proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and the Council on the European Health Data Space;

3. Emphasises

- the importance of accessibility of electronic health data for natural persons (data subjects), i.e. electronic health data for primary use should be easily readable and adequately accessible and electronic health record system should be designed as user-friendly;
- the importance of adequate security of electronic health data within the process of implementation of the Proposal for the purpose of protecting patients from the misuse of their health data;
- the need to eliminate the negative impacts resulting from the implementation of the Proposal, especially the administrative burden, on the primary activity of the health data processor;

1. Requests

the Government to inform the Senate no later than on 31st January 2023 about the way this Resolution was taken into account and about the further development of negotiations;
