The Senate

I.

1. Supports

the position of the Government of the Czech Republic to this Communication;

2. Draws attention to the urgent need

- to complete the revision of the rules on conflict of interest and to clarify the definition of beneficial ownership;
- to legislatively strengthen the institutional and financial independence of public service media;
- and to take measures to reduce the length of court proceedings;

3. Does not consider it necessary

to adopt a Code of Ethics for members of Parliament, as is stated in one of the recommendations for the Czech Republic, as the provisions of the Constitution of the Czech Republic and the rules of procedure of both chambers are fully sufficient for these pursposes;

II.

1. Requests

the Government to inform the Senate no later than on 31st March 2023 about the way this Resolution was taken into account;

2. Authorises

the President of the Senate to forward this Resolution to the European Commission.
