Dear President.

The Commission would like to thank the Bundesrat for its Opinion on the Communication from the Commission to the European Parliament, the Council, the European Economic and Social Committee and the Committee of the Regions "A Union of Equality: Gender Equality Strategy 2020-2025" {COM(2020) 152 final}.

We appreciate that the Bundesrat decided to analyse this Strategy and welcomes the support for its aims and the conclusion that action at the European level is necessary to achieve gender equality. The Commission thanks the German Bundesrat for its very pertinent remarks regarding the situation of trans and intersex persons. The Commission is attentive to difficulties and unequal treatment faced by transgender and intersex persons, which are a daily reality for many people in Europe. It has offered support to Member States, civil society and businesses in combatting these problems and promoting diversity. The specific concerns of trans and intersex persons will be addressed in the upcoming LGBTI+ equality strategy, which will be adopted later this year.

In the context of the above, the Commission would be very grateful to be able to count on the support of the German Council Presidency in the negotiations on two legislative proposals which are currently not moving forward – the Directive on Gender Balance in corporate boards¹, and the Equal Treatment Directive². The same goes for the proposal on pay transparency, which the Commission will present later this year.
