Comments on:

Proposal for a Council regulation concerning the extension of the scope of Regulation (EU) of the European Parliament and of the Council No xx/yy on the professional cross-border transportation of euro cash by road between euro-area Member States (COM (2010) 376)

The 14th Standing Committee, following consideration of the aforementioned document,

expresses, insofar as its remit is concerned, a positive opinion with the following qualifications:

the legal basis is properly identified [...];

the proposal appears to comply with the subsidiarity principle [...];

the proposal appears to comply with the proportionality principle [...];

expresses perplexity on the Commission's decision to submit only proposal no. 376 to the assessment of national parliaments' and not proposal no. 377 including the substantive regulation of cross-border transportation of euro cash, in view of the considerations expressed in the framework of the annual report 2009 on the relations between the European Commission and national parliaments (*Doc. XVIII, n. 47*).
