Proposal for a directive of the European Parliament and of the Council amending Directive 2000/25/EC as regards the provisions for tractors placed on the market under the flexibility scheme (COM (2010) 607 final)

The 14th Standing Committee, following consideration of the aforementioned document,

expresses, insofar as its remit is concerned, a positive opinion with the following qualifications:

the legal basis is properly identified [...];

the proposal appears to comply with the subsidiarity principle [...];

the proposal appears to comply with the proportionality principle [...];

the proposal meets the industry's need to bear the implementation costs necessary in order to adapt to the new legal requirements for the purposes of re-designing the engines and developing advanced technical solutions; such costs are aggravated by the economic recession in the sector concerned. The amendments proposed do not prejudice the objective of Directive 2000/25/EC to protect human health and the environment by reducing the emission of pollutants by engines intended to power agricultural or forestry tractors.
