ON THE

**PROPOSAL FOR A REGULATION OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL ESTABLISHING THE EUROPEAN AGENCY FOR SAFETY AND HEALTH AT WORK (EU-OSHA), AND REPEALING COUNCIL REGULATION (EC) 2062/94 (COM (2016) 528 final)**

*pursuant to Article 144(1) and (6) of the Rules of Procedure*

The Committee,

having examined the proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council establishing the European Agency for Safety and Health at Work (EU-OSHA), and repealing Council Regulation (EC) 2062/94;

Whereas the role of EU-OSHA is defined as shaping policies on health and safety at work as a centre for the technical, scientific, legal and economic information and qualified expertise of use in the field of safety and health at work.

Noting that the proposal for a Regulation under consideration will enable EU-OSHA to be aligned with the Common Approach on the other European Union Decentralised Agencies (Eurofound and CEDEFOP);

having concluded that the proposal upholds the principles of proportionality and subsidiarity;

hereby issues a favourable opinion..
