The Commission would like to thank the Committee on European Affairs of the Assembleia da República for its Opinion on the proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council establishing Horizon Europe – the Framework Programme for Research and Innovation and laying down the rules for its participationand dissemination {COM(2018) 435 final}, the proposal for a Decision of the European Parliament and of the Council establishing the specific programme implementing Horizon Europe, the Framework Programme for Research and Innovation {COM(2018) 436 final} and the proposal for a Council Regulation establishing the Research and Training Programme of the European Atomic Energy Community for the period 2021-2025 complementing Horizon Europe, the Framework Programme for Research and Innovation {COM(2018) 437 final}.
